Dear Oak Grove Community,

Thank you to everyone who attended the OGS Board of Education meeting in person or through our streaming option. Please see the brief recap of the December meeting.

- 1. The Board approved the transfer of \$900,000 from the Education Fund to the Capital Projects Fund, the transfer of \$700,000 from the Transportation Fund to the Operations and Maintenance Fund, and the transfer of \$1,000,000 from the Operations and Maintenance Fund to the Capital Projects Fund. A public hearing was held prior to the approval with no public comment given. These transfers are to accommodate the expenses of future facility projects.
- 2. The Board of Education approved the final audit report for FY23. There were no audit findings in the report.
- 3. The Board of Education formally approved the purchase of AV equipment in the amount of \$58,313.35 for the Pat Patt gym. The equipment will allow for large community and staff gatherings in one space. The Oak Grove School Education Foundation has graciously agreed to donate funds raised from this year's gala to support this initiative.
- 4. The Board of Education approved a contract with Veregy in the amount of \$242,682 for 2024 summer building maintenance projects. In particular, rooftop units will be removed and replaced to support the cooling of identified classrooms and teaching spaces. This project was identified as a priority on the district long-term facilities plan.
