

OAK GROVE BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING 4-24-18

This is a summary of events that occurred at the April meeting, not the official minutes.

Superintendent's Report

- Student Celebration The Board honored the following students:
 - Brandon LaCrosse "You Be the Chemist"
 - Matt Berner Oak Grove & Regional Spelling Bee champion
 - Oscar Butler & Sam Pinsel IESA State wrestling qualifiers
- Multicultural Committee Event is on May 3, 6:00-7:30pm, we have 50 booths in this event
- Legislation Dr. Lemon along with other area superintendents continue to work with legislators to oppose bills that are detrimental to Oak Grove or contain unfunded mandates

Public Comment

- Community members addressed the Board requesting recognition of the annual Muslim holidays
- Mr. Nee, PE teacher, retiring this year, thanked the Board for always supporting him
- Mrs. Saia read a letter regarding district leadership concerning a recent staff appointment

New Business/Information

- Dr. Cacciatore gave a curriculum report (attached to BoardBook)
- Dr. Lemon reported the Foundation is looking forward to next year; they are currently looking at the process of restructuring and clarifying the grant process. Typically it has been focused on STEM. The application process was adjusted; they've received some unique applications for grants. Foundation grants will likely be subdivided by different topics, restructured into three categories. Meeting in May to elect their officers for next year & continue grant work
- SEDOL- Meeting is this Thursday. Mundelein High School petitioned the ROE board of trustees to withdraw from SEDOL. Up to \$1.2 million may have to be absorbed by the remaining districts in the consortium due to the withdrawal
- Standards Based Grading Committee Update Committee will come to the Board next month with a recommendation. 25 parents came to our parent night, very good turnout, and a majority of the committee attended
